


Using Bridge to create a contact sheet




Launch **Bridge** from the **Br** icon at the top of Photoshop - shown below in orange but it starts grey!




Make sure all the images are in the same folder. Browse to the folder in Bridge and then select one of the images. Press **Ctrl-A** to select all. If you want to omit one or more then **Ctrl-Click** on each.

Choose **OUTPUT** from the options at the top, (not **ESSENTIALS**, **FILMSTRIP** or **METADATA**)

On the right ensure that **PDF** is selected rather than **Web Gallery** and set the document Page preset to **International Paper**. Choose **A4** or **A3**.



To keep your file size down I recommend dropping the Quality resolution to 150ppi (which will be 25% the filesize of 300ppi) and choosing a Quality of 60%. Decide on the number of rows and columns. This will directly effect the size of your printed images. You can choose whether or not to have the filenames (and extensions) printed and whether to rotate images to fill the space more effectively.



Preview to see if you have it right, then **Save** to view and print in Acrobat Reader.
